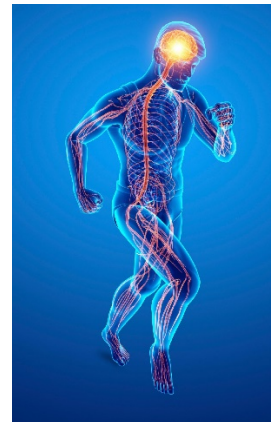
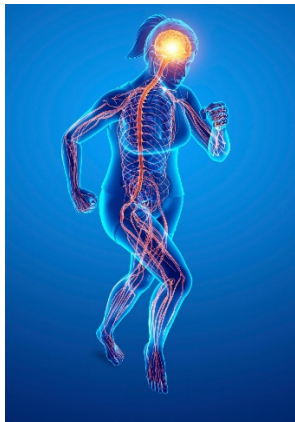




Movement Disorders Under the Magnifying Glass
